

“Kitty’s Litters Litter”

 Time for make: **3 hours + drying time.**

This is what you will need:

- Large cardboard boxes.
- Glue gun OR strong glue and a brush.
- Masking tape.
- Gold spray paint OR metallic paint.
- Black paint and yellow paint.
- 2 x A3 paper OR 1 x A1 paper.
- Thick black permanent marker pen.



Steps

1



Cut open the boxes to see how much cardboard you have.

If you have enough cardboard without doing this step, go on to step 3.



2



Cut all the folded parts off the boxes apart from the top.

Attach the two parts of cardboard together using a glue or masking tape.

3



Use some of the other pieces of cardboard to make 2 poles (if you don't have wood, or a broom pole etc to use). Fold the cardboard into quarters and then secure using duck tape.

Paint or spray paint the cardboard and tubes. You can also use gold duck tape if you don't want to wait for drying time.

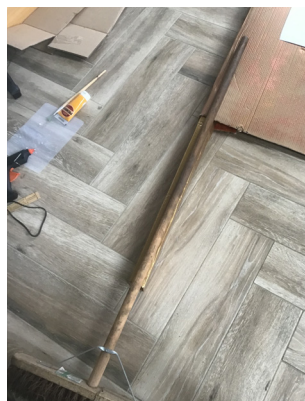
Once dry, Glue on the white paper (This can be a colour of your choice, you may want to choose a metallic paper!)

6



Glue the poles on. I left the folded parts of cardboard on so it would help to hold the poles.

You can follow this process if you use wooden poles too. Use could use garden cane or broom handles! (Take the broom off first!)



7



Plan out the writing “Kitty’s Litters” on the white sign and paint in a choice of colour. Go around the outside of the paper in black acrylic or metallic paint.

With pencil, mark out a roman pattern around the outside of the cardboard.

You can be as creative as you want with this part. Paint in black acrylic or use thick permanent marker for more stability.

9



Outline the lettering once dry.

Admire your handy work, fit for a Roman Emperor!
