## "Oversized Remote"



Time for make: 1.5 hours + drying time.

## This is what you will need:

- 2 x child-sized shoe boxes or similar sized cardboard boxes.
- Black acrylic paint or black spray paint.
- Masking tape (use masking tape as Sellotape is shiny).
- Foam washing up sponges, other foam shapes or the inside tube from a roll of cling film or silver foil.
- White acrylic paint or white Sharpie pen.
- Small brush.
- Glue gun.
- Craft knife or strong scissors.

## Steps



Take the two cardboard shoe boxes. Make sure they will fit together at the narrow end.





Glue both ends of the shoeboxes and stick together tightly.





Measure and mark at  $2\ \mathrm{cm}$  intervals on the cardboard tube or foam sponges.





Use a craft knife to cut the shapes out.



Use the glue gun to stick each circle / or foam pad to the box. It should look like this when complete.








Use the masking tape to cover the box.





Once you have covered the box with masking tape, begin taping over the buttons. (You can add screwed up paper tissue inside the buttons to bulk out the shape before covering)



Once the masking tape is dry, paint the remote with black acrylic paint. Alternatively mix poster paint with some PVA glue to make it stronger. Let it dry.



Use white paint and the small brush or the white Sharpie pen to paint/draw the numbers and controls on the remote.
You can then decorate however you choose!



Wait for all paint to dry. Your completed oversized remote ready for the children to use!
