LIST OF PROPERTIES

Very few props are required for the staging of this Easy Peasy Nativity.

Listed below are the key props indicated in the script, together with an indication of which character(s) or scene, they will be used in.

langerStable Manger Scene
aby Jesus Doll in a ShawlPlaced in the Manger (undercover until Narrator 5's lines)
amb Soft Toy(s)Shepherds
tar on a Pole (if a prop is used instead of a child dressed as a star)Star Bearer
ifts x 3 (Gold, Frankincense and Myrrh)Wise Men

(SONG ACTIONS: during the song, suggest all Choir, Actors and Action Dancers to raise arms to the side (open palmed) in a questioning stance for every occurrence of 'What was it like...' throughout the song and at each point there is a question (lines 2 and 4). All Choir, Actors and Action Dancers place hands over heart and look upward as if wishing at the line 'I wish I'd been there...'

In verses 1, 2 and 3, suggest all Choir, Actors and Action Dancers are seated and rocking from side to side (in sync, starting to rock to the right) until the last line of each verse 'Born to bring us love...', when all above hold their arms around themselves as if giving themselves a hug.)

(ACTOR ACTIONS: during Narrator 1's lines, suggest Mary sitting / lying on Main Performance Area. Angel Gabriel to step on Main Performance Area and link arms as if to signify cradling & rocking a baby using the cue, 'she would give birth to a very special baby'. On hearing this, Mary to put her hands to her mouth and look surprised then put her hands to her heart.)

NARRATOR 1: Long, long ago... far, far away lived Mary and Joseph. One night,

Mary was visited by the Angel Gabriel who told her she would give

birth to a very special baby.

(ACTOR ACTIONS: Angel Gabriel to exit stage at end of Narrator 1's lines. Joseph and the Donkey to join Mary in the Main Performance Area and then begin walking together from side to side or round and round the Main Performance Area (depending on available space.) During Narrator 2's lines, suggest action continues, as above, with Mary, Joseph and the Donkey traversing the stage throughout Narrator 2's lines and the song 'Travelling to Bethlehem'.)

NARRATOR 2: A Census was ordered which meant all people had to be counted in

their hometown. Mary and Joseph began a very long journey to

Joseph's hometown of Bethlehem.

(SONG ACTIONS: during the song, suggest all Choir, Actors and Action Dancers to do a 'walking' action with their arms throughout Verse 1. Throughout Verse 2, the Choir, Actors and Action Dancers to repeat wiping their foreheads with their forearms alternately to indicate being hot. In Verse 3, the Choir, Actors and Action Dancers to repeat a yawning action with arms stretched up as if very tired and worn out.)
