SCENE ONE:

AGGREGIA'S BAKERY

(Backdrop: Roman street scene. Aggregia's Bakery and Café Chino in the foreground, fruit stall and houses etc. further back.)

(In front of the bakery stall, on the backdrop, is a table with baked goods and a money bag.)

<u> TRACK 1:</u>

I'M ON A ROLL (SONG)

(Enter a rooster and two hens, who strut around the stage pecking at bits on the ground.)

(Enter Gladis with a basket full of bakes, she sprinkles a few crumbs for the chickens, who gobble them up.) Characters enter [as indicated in the lyrics] and walk across the stage interacting with each other. These characters plus the chickens, form the Chorus and should split into Groups 1 and 2 at bar 40.)

GLADIS: STEPPIN' OUT IN THE MORNIN,' ALWAYS FIRST ON PATRO-O-OL.

(Enter two people carrying baskets of fruit.)

CALLIN' 'CIAO' TO THE NEIGHBOURS,

(She waves to the Fruit Sellers.)

EV'RYTHINGS IN CONTRO-O-O-OL. SELLING MY BAKIN,'

GLADIS	
& CHORUS:	EARNING A CRUST.
GLADIS:	BAKES FOR THE TAKIN,'
GLADIS	
& CHORUS:	HEY, GUYS, YOU MUST -
	GET UP, GET UP!

(Enter Customers 1-4.)

GLADIS:	DON'T WANNA BE A SLEEPYHEAD. I SAID,
GLADIS

(Enter Litter Bearers with a litter marked 'Kitty's Litters' carrying Kittina. They park up and mingle.)

GLADIS: LOVIN' BEING A BAKER; ALWAYS GIVES ME A GLO-O-O-OW, WATCH THE RISE IN THE OVEN, LIKE A MAGICAL SHO-O-O-OW. IT'S A CHAIN REACTION TURNIN' FLOUR TO GO-O-OLD. IT'S THE MAIN ATTRACTION; JUST WANT YOU TO KNOW -

(Enter Hennius right, who rounds up his hens. Gladis gives a loaf of bread to the Old Lady for free.)

(Exit all, except Gladis and Caustica.)

GLADIS: Caustica, what's the matter?



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CAUSTICA: (Shaking her finger at Gladis.) I saw you giving away free bread! Do you think we are made of money?GLADIS: But the poor old lady was hungry.

(They walk towards the bakery. Enter Billius who starts 'eating' the bakes on the table.)

CAUSTICA:	You had no right. That woman needed to pay for her bread like everyone else.
BILLIUS:	(<i>Through a mouth full of pancake.</i>) Yeh, we are not a charity! We'll take the cost of that loaf out of your wages!
GLADIS:	But you don't pay me any wages!
CAUSTICA:	We promised your poor mother to look after you and your brother, - your board and lodging is your wage!
BILLIUS:	(Tauntingly.) Yeh Gladis, so you can't even pay for that bread!
CAUSTICA:	Billius, that is your fifth pancake this morning! (<i>Billius reaches out for a large bun, but Caustica bats his hand away.</i>) And those are for sale.
GLADIS:	That poor lady is a widow and can't afford the prices you charge. And she's not the only one. I'm embarrassed to take the money sometimes.
CAUSTICA:	How dare you! I charge fair prices, anyway people wouldn't buy if they thought we were too expensive.
BILLIUS:	(Looks underneath the table and brings out an enormous cake which he starts to eat.) Mmmmm, I've got to say Gladis, this is delicious
CAUSTICA:	<i>(Turns round to see Billius eating the large cake and shrieks).</i> Billius! That was the special order for Café Chino!
BILLIUS:	Stop nagging woman, Gladis can make another one. I'm off out for a snack. Can't get a decent meal round here! (Unseen by the others, he helps himself to some money from the money bag, and quickly counts it.) That should be enough!

(Exit Billius. Enter Precarious, carrying two sacks of flour; enter Customers 3 and 4.)

CAUSTICA: And where have you been? (She turns to serve the customers and doesn't hear Precarious' first answer.)

- **PRECARIOUS:** (Cheekily to Gladis.) Let me see... I had breakfast with a Senator at the forum, then I went to the Imperial Palace to discuss the progress of the Ninth Legion in Brittania...
- GLADIS: (Warningly.) Precarious!



(Exit customers.)

PRECARIOUS:	(Meekly to Caustica.) At the mill where you told me to go.
CAUSTICA:	Well, your sister has been waiting for this flour, she needs to be baking! Time is money! And now she will be working overtime for an extra order for Café Chino.
GLADIS:	(Aside to Precarious.) Because Billius ate the last one!

(*Precarious picks up an oven mitt and mimics Caustica behind her back making a 'mouth' glove puppet during the next exchange of dialogue.*)

CAUSTICA:	There has been enough delay. Get to work Gladis.
GLADIS:	Caustica, couldn't we charge less for the bread? It costs very little to make. The rich cakes bring in lots of money, but the ordinary bread is too expensive.
CAUSTICA:	We are not here to make bread for the poor! It makes no money! Anyway, since when have you been the owner of this bakery? You have no idea of the overheads and profits I need to make.
GLADIS:	I do know my cakes and bakes sell very well, so surely
CAUSTICA:	I will not have my staff telling me what to do! You had better watch yourself girl and know your place! Now we have another thirty loaves, flatbreads, pancakes, date pasties, honey rolls oh, and that special order for Café Chino (She turns around to see Precarious mimicking her.) Why you little (She grabs a broom and chases Precarious off the stage.)

TRACK 2: I'M ON A ROLL PLAY OFF/PALACE PLAY ON

SCENE TWO: THE IMPERIAL PALACE

(Backdrop: The Imperial Palace.)

(Enter Pompous and Media who 'recline' on two garden loungers facing the audience, with a small table between them. The table has a silver dish of food delicacies on it. Two servants stand behind, fanning them with large fans on long sticks.)

MEDIA: *(Offers the dish to Pompous.)* Another flamingo tongue Emperor? I had them imported from Sardinia.



POMPOUS:	Err…no thank you (Choosing what to have.) I'll try a stuffed
	dormouse instead. (He takes it from the dish.) Now, I think it's time
	for a little entertainment.
MEDIA:	Of course ! (She claps her hands for attention.) Summon the Palace Poet!

(Enter Ninnius with a lyre.)

NINNIUS:	Your Imperial Majesties! (He makes a low outrageous bow.)
POMPOUS:	(<i>Pompously.)</i> Entertain us Ninnius, we are in need of some distraction!
NINNIUS:	<i>(Strums the strings of his lyre, which are horribly out of tune.)</i> With pleasure, here is a little ditty I have just composed.
	Ahem… (He clears his throat.)
	A clever young lady called Cilla
	Had cracks in her old Roman villa.
	The builder said nope,
	Won't do it, can't cope.
	So, she plastered it with Polyfilla!
POMPOUS:	(Not impressed.) Is that the best you can do?
NINNIUS:	Oh! <i>(Disappointed.)</i> Well, how about this one? It's entitled 'In Celebration of our Empress'.
MEDIA:	That sounds promising, carry on. (She pats her hair vainly, expecting compliments.)
NINNIUS:	Oh good. Ahem… (He clears his throat.)

(During the poem, Media gets angrier and angrier, and Pompous thinks it is very funny.)

NINNIUS:Dear Media, you've beauty, of course,
Although you have teeth like a horse.
Your nose is quite big
Like an over-ripe fig
Which turns red when you blow it with force!

MEDIA: *(Furious.)* Get him out!

(Exit Ninnius hurriedly.)

POMPOUS: (Laughing.) Well, I asked to be entertained...

(Enter Helvetica.)

HELVETICA:	Madam, the Merchant has arrived.
MEDIA:	Send him in; I need some retail therapy!

(Enter the Merchant with a wheeled trolley, labelled: 'Mercarto's – Do Not Remove from the Chariot Park.')

(Media stands up and sneezes loudly.)

POMPOUS:	Guzuntus!
MERCHANT:	<i>(Bows.)</i> Media Influenza!
MEDIA:	It's not 'influenza' - it's influenCER!
MERCHANT:	My apologies Your Majesty, Media Influencer. (Bows again.)
	I have a selection of must-have items from around the Empire.
MEDIA:	Good. I'll use them for this week's blog. Helvetica, get ready to take notes.
HELVETICA:	Yes Ma'am. (He produces a tablet and stylus.)
MERCHANT:	First we have this new perfume from Egypt. (He gives a bottle to Media.)
MEDIA:	<i>(Rubs a bit on her wrist and sniffs her wrist.)</i> Mmm, very nice - what's it called?
MERCHANT:	Cleopatra.
MEDIA:	(Scoffs.) Not very original, but I like the perfume. Helvetica, scribe please.
HELVETICA:	Stylus poised Ma'am.

(Helvetica writes on his tablet as Media dictates in an enthusiastic, advertising voice.)

- MEDIA: Hey guys, you have got to try this cool fragrance inspired by the queen of black eyeliner herself – Cleopatra! Delicate hints of rose petals are built on smoky tones of cinnamon and sandalwood, in a pyramid of perfumes! (*To Pompous*) Did you see what I did there? Pyramid of perfumes? Egypt, Cleopatra?
- **POMPOUS:** (Uninterested.) Yes. Very good dear, your followers will love that.



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HELVETICA:	Do you want an image Ma'am?
MEDIA:	Yes. Sketch please.

(Media poses sideways like an Egyptian wall painting, holding the bottle of perfume in the flat of her hand. Whilst Helvetica hastily sketches her.)

POMPOUS:	What else have you got Merchant?
MERCHANT:	I have some purple silk.
MEDIA:	(Very excited.) Oh, my goodness, purple silk! Purple!
MERCHANT:	(Happily.) Yes purple, from the Middle East.

(He hands a piece to Media, who strokes it and runs it through her hands.)

MEDIA: HELVETICA: MERCHANT: MEDIA: HELVETICA: MERCHANT:	 Helvetica, you will need a new tablet for this one. Yes Ma'am. (<i>He starts a new tablet.</i>) This costly purple dye, is made from a species of sea snails (<i>Excitedly.</i>) Did you get that Helvetica? Yes Ma'am. Who are boiled for days in giant vats, producing a terrible smell
MEDIA:	Err, we'll cut that bit.
HELVETICA:	Good decision Ma'am. Shall I just finish off?
MEDIA:	Yes, time for a quick selfie before you leave…

(Media drapes the purple fabric around her, takes the tablet off Helvetica and pouts as if taking a selfie.)

MEDIA: Something like that Helvetica, then post it in the forum.

(Enter Ninnius to sing in the chorus.)

(Chorus sung by Pompous, Merchant, Servants, Helvetica and Ninnius. They split into Groups 1 and 2 during the song.)

(Enter Strictus.)

STRICTUS:	Hail Pompous Maximus Caesar! <i>(He salutes.)</i>
POMPOUS:	(Nods.) Senator Strictus.
STRICTUS:	Hail Media Influenza!
MEDIA:	It's Media InfluenCER! (She sneezes.)
STRICTUS	
& POMPOUS:	Guzuntus!
MEDIA:	Getta Agrippa?
STRICTUS:	Err, no need to be so rude Ma'am!



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MEDIA:	No, I mean, where's Getta Agrippa?
STRICTUS:	(Realises the mistake.) Ohh! He's on his way, he's been delayed by
	the rioting.

(Enter Agrippa.)

TRACK 5:	SFX NEGATIVE BUZZER
AGRIPPA:	When in Rome do as the Romans do?
STRICTUS:	No.
POMPOUS:	All roads lead to Rome?
STRICTUS:	Hmm, well we all know that famous saying about Rome?
AGRIPPA:	Yes, we must get a grip on this problem, find a solution.
MEDIA:	Hmm, until we find out the cause of the problem, we need to do something to keep the people happy, the Emperor must not become unpopular.
STRICTUS:	I suspect some bakers are overcharging, the people are going hungry, and this is causing the unrest.
MEDIA:	The bakers are given extra money to make bread for the poor, so why is the bread so expensive?
POMPOUS:	Crumbs!
AGRIPPA:	Sire, its bad news: the mob are complaining about the price of bread.
MEDIA:	It wasn't that funny Pompous!
POMPOUS:	Getta Agrippa on those riots? <i>(He laughs.)</i>
AGRIPPA:	(Confused.) Sire?
POMPOUS:	Getta Agrippa, about time! And did you?
AGRIPPA:	Hail Pompous Maximus Caesar!

POMPOUS: An apple a day keeps the Romans away?

(Strictus gives a loud, disappointed sigh.)

MEDIA: STRICTUS:	Oh, for goodness sake! Tell us Strictus! 'Bread and Circuses'. Keep the people happy with bread and circuses.
POMPOUS:	Well, I've never heard of that before! So, you think we should stage some entertainment?
AGRIPPA:	How about chariot races?
POMPOUS:	Boring! We did that last time.
AGRIPPA:	Gladiator games in the Colosseum!



MEDIA:	Oh no! Too blood thirsty!
POMPOUS:	But the mob like it and it keeps them quiet.
MEDIA:	<i>(Thinking.)</i> Bread and circuses how about we combine the two and have a baking competition in the Colosseum?!
POMPOUS:	A baking competition? Well, that's different!
STRICTUS:	But no Gladiators…
AGRIPPA:	Well, we could throw in a lion or two and the odd fighter
POMPOUS:	It's a big risk; no one has ever held a baking competition before.
STRICTUS:	Why don't we ask the Imperial Augur? He can consult the Gods for us. He'll read the signs from his Sacred Chickens and tell us if this is the right decision.
MEDIA:	Good Idea! (Claps hands, and shouts.) Send for Hennius Peck, Keeper of the Sacred Chickens!
TRACK 6:	IT DEPENDS ON THE HENS (SONG)

(Pompous, Media, Strictus and Agrippa sing the chorus.) (Enter Hennius and his three chickens.)

HENNIUS:	YO! I SEE YOU'RE LOOKIN' FOR A PROPHECY, YEAH? WE'LL GET A MESSAGE IF THE GODS AGREE. YOU KNOW, THESE GUYS ARE SACRED NOT FOR KFC. IT DEPENDS ON THE HENS, IF THEY TALK TO ME.
CHICKENS:	WAAH!
HENNIUS:	THE PECKING ORDER IS NO GUARANTEE. IT'S SCIENTIFIC WATCHING POULTRY YEAH! THESE CHICKEN LICKENS HAVE TO WANDER FREE. IT DEPENDS ON THE HENS, IF THEY TALK TO ME.
CHORUS:	IT DEPENDS ON THE HENS, ON THE WAY THAT THEY EAT; HOW THEY RUFFLE THEIR FEATHERS; HOW THEY SHUFFLE THEIR FEET. GOTTA CHUCK, CHUCK, CHUCK AS THEY STEP IN LINE.
HENNIUS:	THERE'S A SIGN! THERE'S A SIGN!
CHORUS:	IS IT GENUINE?



HENNIUS: IT'S A YES, YES, YES. IT'S A NO, NO, NO. FROM THE WISHBONE TO THE PARSON'S NOSE. GONNA PECK THE GRIT, GONNA FEEL THE VIBE. GOTTA WAIT UNTIL THE GODS DECIDE.

(Chickens mime and act out the noises to the egg laying sounds on the track.)

LEAD HEN:	(Egg laying improvisation and screech.)
HENNIUS:	<i>(Holds up the egg reverently.)</i> Oh, my goodness this is egg-ceptional, the Gods have sent us an egg!
POMPOUS:	Actually, I think the chicken did that!
HENNIUS:	Don't you see? Your baking competition has been blessed with an egg. You have the divine thumbs up from Olympus!
POMPOUS:	Yay! Well let's get cracking!
MEDIA:	(To Strictus and Agrippa.) Arrange a meeting with the Colosseum Committee for tomorrow. We have a 'Great Roman Bake Off' to organise!

(Exit all.)

SCENE THREE:

CAFÉ CHINO

(Backdrop: Roman Street scene, with three tables and five chairs and a bench to one side, outside Café Chino).

(Enter Customers 1-4, who sit at the front two tables which have four chairs between them.)

(Enter Marcus and Servant 1 who move between the tables serving food and drinks.) (Enter Billius who sits at the table at the back of the group on the single chair.)

- BILLIUS: *(Rudely and loudly.)* Hey Marcus, get a move on! What's happened to my order?!
- MARCUS: (Patiently.) It's on its way Billius. You only ordered it a minute ago!
- BILLIUS: It had better be, I'm starving!

(Enter Servant 2 who hurries anxiously with Billius's order.)

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
